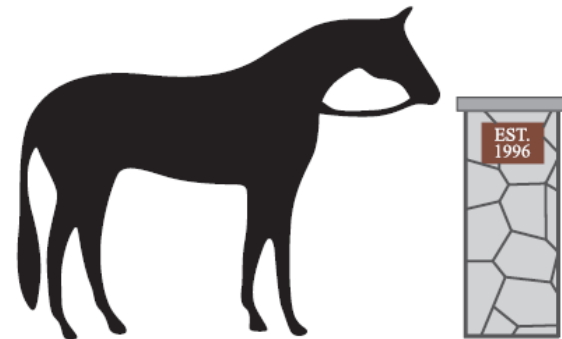

Directions to Stonehouse Stables:

From North West (Richmond) - take I-64 East to Exit 227. Bear Right on Route 30. At first stoplight Route 30 turns into Route 60. Go straight. Approx. 2 miles, turn right on Route 610 (Forge Road) as you enter Toano. Fire Station visible at turn. Go 2.3 miles. Stonehouse Stables is on the right. Look for the sign.

From South East (Williamsburg) – Take I-64 West to exit 231-A. Turn right on Route 60 west. Turn left, at Fire Station, on to Forge Rd (Route 610). Go 2.3 miles. Stonehouse Stables is on the right. Look for the sign

Rules and Regulations:

1. Some shows are members of CHSA, all are Associate member of VHSA, as well as Stonehouse Summer Show Series (SSSS).
2. Six ribbons will be awarded in all classes. Division champions receive a prize and ribbon & reserve champions receive a ribbon. Points will count toward annual high score awards. Fewer than 6 entries will allow for classes to be combine at managements disgration.
3. Hard hats are required at all times when mounted. **All riders must wear an approved helmet at all times.**
4. A horse or pony must have been entered in at least one class over fences in a division to be eligible for the under saddle class.
5. **A Negative coggins is required of all animals on the grounds.**
6. This show is run in accordance with the ground rules of the VHSA, with the exception of fence heights.
7. Any talking to the judge is prohibited and judge placing is final.
8. Stonehouse Stables reserves the right to refuse any entry; to change the time schedule; to combine classes; or change judges at any time.
9. There will be no posted jump order except equitation classes.
10. The one-minute rule may be enforced, both for entering the ring and returning to jog.
11. Stonehouse Stables will not be responsible for accidents or loss of property.
12. All dogs must be leashed.
13. No stallions permitted on grounds.
14. All riding is done at your own risk according to VA Equestrian law & all on property are considered participants or spectators. Any one wishing not to be a participant or spectator must view the show from the office lounge.

Division Specifications:

Special Hunter: Open to horses or ponies to jumps 2' or 2'6". To be judged on performance and way of going.

Schooling Hunter: Open to horses and large ponies to jump 2'9". To be judged on performance and way of going.

Large Pony: Open to junior riders on large ponies. Jumps 2'9". To be judged on performance and way of going.

Open Hunter: Open to horses only to jumps 3' or 3'3". To be judged on performance and way of going.

Green Hunter: Open to horses in their first year of showing over fences at 3' or above. First year horses jump 3' and second year horses to jump 3'3".

Junior Equitation: Jumps 3'. Open to junior riders on horses only. May not cross enter into any other equitation class. To be judged 100 % on equitation.

Children's Hunter: Open to junior riders on horses only. To jump 3' or 3'3" Riders may not cross enter into Children's/Adult Hunter. To be judged on performance and way of going.

Adult Equitation: Jumps 2'6", 3' or 3'3" Open to adult riders on horses. May not cross enter into any other equitation class. To be judged 100 % on equitation.

Adult Hunter: Open to amateur adult riders on horses. Jumps 3' or 3'3". Rider may not cross enter into Children's/Adult Hunter. To be judged on performance and way of going.

Green Pony Hunter: Open to ponies of any age in their first year of showing in any classes that require ponies to jump the designated height for green ponies. Smalls jump 2', Mediums jump 2'3" and Large ponies jump 2'6".

Pony Equitation: Open to junior riders on ponies. May not cross enter into any other equitation class. To be judged 100 % on equitation. Smalls jump 2', Mediums jump 2'6 and Larges jump 2'9".

Small/Medium Pony Hunter: Open to junior riders on small or medium ponies. Smalls jump 2' and Mediums jump 2'3". To be judged on performance and way of going.

Children's/Adult Hunter: Open to junior or amateur rides on horses. Fences 2' or 2'6" riders may not cross enter into Children's or Adult hunter. To be judged on performance and way of going.

Children's/Adult Equitation: Open to junior or amateur riders on horses. Fences 2' or 2'6" Rider may not cross enter into any other equitation class. . To be judged 100 % on equitation.

Children's Pony Hunter: Open to junior riders on ponies to jump 2'. To be judged on performance and way of going. May not cross enter into Children's hunter, Pony hunters, or Children's/Adult hunter.

Children's Pony Equitation: Open to junior riders on ponies to jump 2'. To be judged performance and way of going. May not cross enter into junior equitation, pony equitation, or Children's/Adult equitation.

Pre-Short Stirrup Equitation: Open to junior riders 12 and under on horses or ponies. Riders must demonstrate walk, trot and canter at various positions and jump 2 cross rails no higher than 12" May not cross enter in any division. (Not a CHSA or VHSA Division)

Short Stirrup Equitation: Open to horses and ponies ridden by junior riders age 12 and under. Will consist of two over fences classes with jumps 18", a walk trot class, and walk trot canter class. The walk trot class will not count toward VHSA Associate points, but will be taken into account for the division championship. Riders may only cross-enter into a pleasure division. To be judged on performance of horse and rider.

Pleasure Pony: Open to junior riders on ponies shown with hunter tack on the flat. Riders will be asked to walk trot canter and show their mount at the judge's discretion.

Junior Hunter Pleasure Horse: Open to junior riders on horses shown with hunter tack on the flat. Riders will be asked to walk trot canter and show their mount at the judge's discretion.

Adult Hunter Pleasure Horse: Open to adult riders on horses shown with hunter tack on the flat. Riders will be asked to walk trot canter and show their mount at the judge's discretion.
