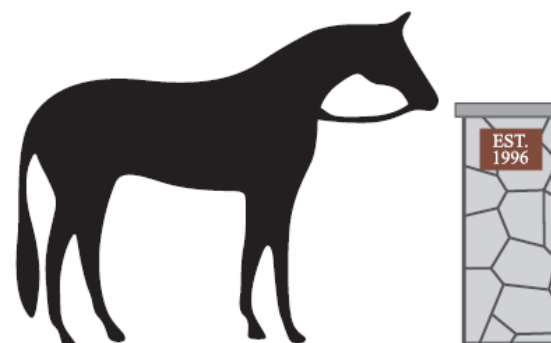

Directions to Stonehouse Stables:

From North West (Richmond) - take I-64 East to Exit 227. Bear Right on Route 30. At first stoplight Route 30 turns into Route 60. Go straight. Approx. 2 miles, turn right on Route 610 (Forge Road) as you enter Toano. Fire Station visible at turn. Go 2.3 miles. Stonehouse Stables is on the right. Look for the sign.

From South East (Williamsburg) – Take I-64 West to exit 231-A. Turn right on Route 60 west. Turn left, at Fire Station, on to Forge Rd (Route 610). Go 2.3 miles. Stonehouse Stables is on the right. Look for the sign.

Rules and Regulations:

1. All shows are members of CHSA and Associate members of VHSA.
2. Six ribbons will be awarded in all classes. Division champions receive a prize and ribbon & reserve champions receive a ribbon. Points will count towards annual high score awards. Classes with fewer than six entries may be combined at management's discretion.
3. Hard hats are required at all times when mounted. **All riders must wear an approved helmet at all times.**
4. A horse/ pony must have been entered in at least one class over fences in a division to be eligible for the under saddle class and must be in the top 4 over fences to be eligible for the Champion or Reserve Champion.
5. **A Negative Coggins is required for all animals on the grounds and a copy must be provided to show secretary.**
6. This show is run in accordance with the ground rules of the VHSA, with the exception of fence heights.
7. Any talking to the judge is prohibited. The judge's placing is final.
8. Stonehouse Stables reserves the right to refuse any entry; to change the time schedule; to combine classes; or change judges at any time.
9. The one-minute rule may be enforced, both for entering the ring and returning to jog.
10. A rider's age is defined by their age as of December 1, 2015.
11. Stonehouse Stables will not be responsible for accidents or loss of property.
12. All dogs must be leashed.
13. No stallions permitted on grounds.
14. All riding is done at your own risk according to VA Equine law & all persons on the property are considered participants or spectators. Anyone not wishing to be a participant or spectator must view the show from the office lounge.
15. A \$25 billing fee will be charged for unpaid show tabs and returned checks.

Division Specifications:

Special Hunter: Open to horses or ponies; fences 2' or 2'6".

Children's/Adult Am. Hunter: Open to children or adult amateurs on horses; fences 2' or 2'6". Riders may not cross enter into any regular horse division or CHSA equitation classes.

Children's/Adult Equitation: Open to children or adult amateur on horses; fences 2' or 2'6". Riders may not cross enter into any other equitation classes except VHSA Equitation on the Flat.

Schooling Hunter: Open to horses only; fences 2'6" or 2'9".

Open Hunter: Open to horses only; fences 3' or 3'3".

Jr. Amateur Schooling Hunter: Open to junior or amateur riders on horses only; fences 2'6" or 2'9".

Children's Hunter: Open to junior riders on horses only; fences 2'9", or 3'. Riders may not cross enter into Children's/Adult Am. Hunter.

Junior Equitation: Open to junior riders on horses only; fences 2'9", or 3'.

Equitation on the Flat: To be shown at a W/T/C, both ways of the ring and judged on position, control and guidance. Tests 1-19 may be used, excluding those requiring work over fences. Class will be split into Junior Equitation on the Flat 15-17, Junior Equitation on the Flat 14 & under and Adult Amateur Equitation on the Flat.

Adult Hunter: Open to amateur adult riders on horses; fences 2'9", or 3'. Rider may not cross enter into Children's/Adult Am. Hunter.

Adult Equitation: Open to adult riders on horses; fences 2'9", or 3'.

Children's Pony Hunter: Open to junior riders on ponies; fences 2' or 2'6". Riders may cross enter into pleasure or special hunter but not into any regular pony divisions or CHSA equitation classes.

Children's Pony Equitation: Open to junior riders on ponies; fences 2' or 2'6". Riders may not cross enter into any other equitation class except VHSA Equitation on the Flat.

Thoroughbred Hunter: Limited to horses that are registered with or who are eligible to be registered with the Jockey Club; fences 2'6" or 2'9".

Green Pony Hunter: Open to ponies of any age in their first year of showing in any classes that require ponies to jump the designated height for green ponies. Smalls jump 2', Mediums jump 2', and Larges jump 2'3". May be combined with Reg. pony division

Pony Hunter: Open to junior riders on ponies. Smalls jump 2', Mediums jump 2'3" and Larges jump 2'6" or 2'9".

Pony Equitation: Open to junior riders on ponies. Riders may not cross enter into any other equitation classes except VHSA Equitation on the flat. Smalls jump 2', Mediums jump 2'3" and Larges jump 2'6" or 2'9".

Pleasure Pony: Open to junior riders on ponies shown with hunter tack on the flat. Riders will be asked to walk, trot, canter and show their mount at the judge's discretion.

Junior Hunter Pleasure Horse: Open to junior riders on horses shown with hunter tack on the flat. Riders will be asked to walk, trot, canter and show their mount at the judge's discretion.

Adult Hunter Pleasure Horse: Open to adult riders on horses shown with hunter tack on the flat. Will be asked to walk, trot, canter and show their mount at the judge's discretion.

Leadline: Riders are escorted by a lead. Judged on Rider's turnout, and position. Riders may not cross enter.

Pre-Short Stirrup Equitation: Open to riders who have not shown at the canter or over fences. Riders must demonstrate the walk & trot at various positions and trot a course of poles. Riders may not cross enter in any other division.

Short Stirrup Hunter: Open to horses and ponies ridden by junior riders age 12 and under as of December 1, 2017. Four fences at 18". Riders and horses cannot cross enter into class where they jump more than 18".

Short Stirrup Equitation: Open to junior riders age 13 and under as of December 1, 2017. Division consists of two over fences classes of 18" jumps, a walk/trot class, and a walk/trot/canter class. Riders may only cross-enter into a pleasure division or short stirrup hunter.

Beginner Equitation: Open to all riders who have not competed over a 2' course as of December 1, 2017. Riders to jump four-six 18' verticals and/or gates. Riders may not cross enter into any other division other than pleasure.

California Warm-up: Offered all day in ring 1 and ring 2. Management has the right to cancel class at any time.

VHSA Children's Medal: VHSA junior members on horses only who have not jumped higher than 3' at a show where entered in the Children's Hunter Division, except in Equitation; to jump 3'.

VHSA Adult Medal: Must be a VHSA Adult member and hold an Amateur card by USEF. Open to horses only; to jump 3'.

Green Hunter: Limited to horses in their first or second year of showing at 3'. First year horses jump 2'9" and second year horses jump 3'.
